# SUSTAINABLE OSLO

Oslo's reputation as a green city is due to a lot more than its many parks and surrounding forests.

Urban planners, politicians and businesses of different kinds all work hard to reduce Oslo's carbon footprint and ensure a sustainable future for everyone. Their efforts were recognized and rewarded by the European Commission, which named Oslo the European Green Capital for 2019.





## SUSTAINABLE CITY PLANNING

Oslo is one of the fastest growing capitals in Europe, and has seen a lot of large construction projects over the last few decades. Sustainability has been a guiding principle for many of them.

## CAR-FREE URBAN LIVING

Oslo's politicians play an important role in the city's ongoing green turn. Through their initiative Bilfritt byliv ('car-free city life'), the local government has closed down street parking and limited traffic to make room for bikes, benches, green lungs, block parties and other things that make people happier and the air cleaner.

## GREEN ENTREPRENEURSHIP

In addition to the large-scale efforts of city developers and politicians, Oslo is full of smaller projects and businesses that do their part in making Oslo a greener city.

## PORT OF OSLO

The Port of Oslo will contribute to long-term sustainable development by facilitating efficient and environmentally friendly port operations and encouraging the use of clean energy, and innovative infrastructure. The Port of Oslo will achieve sustainable growth while increasing port calls, and cargo and passenger volumes without contributing to more greenhouse gas or local air emissions.





# THE HARBOR PROMENADE

Oslo's new harbor promenade combines sightseeing, history, art, architecture, and a little bit of adventure.

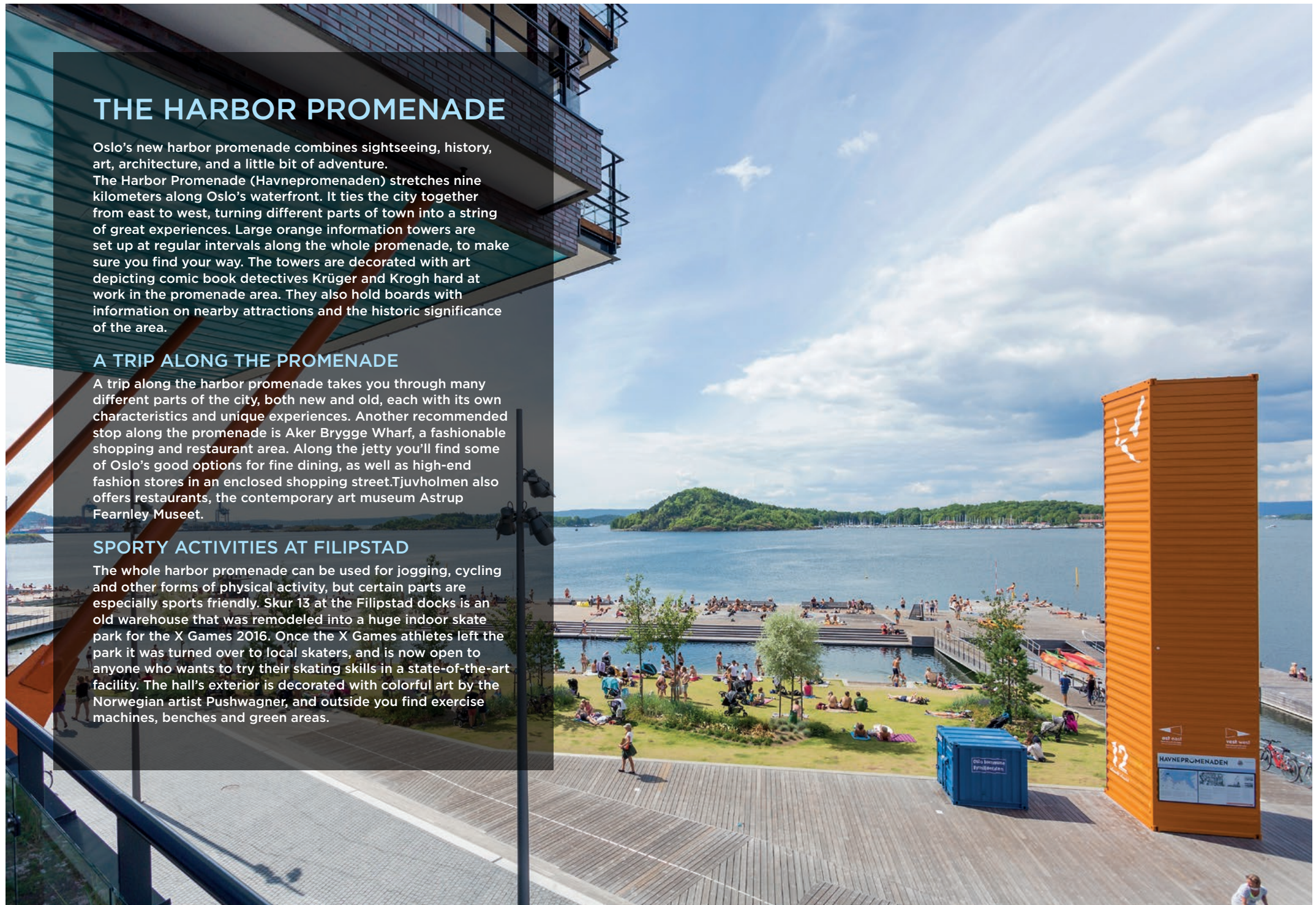
The Harbor Promenade (Havnepromenaden) stretches nine kilometers along Oslo's waterfront. It ties the city together from east to west, turning different parts of town into a string of great experiences. Large orange information towers are set up at regular intervals along the whole promenade, to make sure you find your way. The towers are decorated with art depicting comic book detectives Krüger and Krogh hard at work in the promenade area. They also hold boards with information on nearby attractions and the historic significance of the area.

## A TRIP ALONG THE PROMENADE

A trip along the harbor promenade takes you through many different parts of the city, both new and old, each with its own characteristics and unique experiences. Another recommended stop along the promenade is Aker Brygge Wharf, a fashionable shopping and restaurant area. Along the jetty you'll find some of Oslo's good options for fine dining, as well as high-end fashion stores in an enclosed shopping street. Tjuvholmen also offers restaurants, the contemporary art museum Astrup Fearnley Museet.

## SPORTY ACTIVITIES AT FILIPSTAD

The whole harbor promenade can be used for jogging, cycling and other forms of physical activity, but certain parts are especially sports friendly. Skur 13 at the Filipstad docks is an old warehouse that was remodeled into a huge indoor skate park for the X Games 2016. Once the X Games athletes left the park it was turned over to local skaters, and is now open to anyone who wants to try their skating skills in a state-of-the-art facility. The hall's exterior is decorated with colorful art by the Norwegian artist Pushwagner, and outside you find exercise machines, benches and green areas.

## 1. AKERSHUS FORTRESS

Situated in the centre of Oslo, Akershus Fortress symbolizes over 700 years of Norwegian history. The medieval fortress was built around the year 1300 by King Håkon V, and some parts of the original structure still remain as parts of today's Akershus Castle. With the introduction of cannon warfare, the fortress went through a series of substantial expansions in the 16th and 17th century resulting in today's inner and outer fortress. Throughout its long history, the fortress has among other things functioned as a defensive structure, a royal residence and a penal institution. Today, the fortress is open to the public, enabling visitors to make use of this invaluable piece of Norwegian cultural heritage.

## 2. ASTRUP FEARNLEY MUSEET

Founded in 1993, the Astrup Fearnley Museet is one of Scandinavia's most notable museums for contemporary art. The museum holds the extensive Astrup Fearnley Collection and presents changing exhibitions that both draw on the collection and new commissions by artists from all over the world. The museum building is designed by Renzo Piano and is beautifully located by the fjord. In addition to seeing the exhibitions do stop by the museum shop, the restaurant VentiVenti and take a walk in Tjuvholmen sculpture park. It is possible to book guided tours in the exhibitions. Free entry for children up to 18 years.

## 6. THE NATIONAL MUSEUM OF ART, ARCHITECTURE AND DESIGN

A new joint building for the National Museum is opening in June 2022. It will include Art, Architecture, Design, Crafts and Contemporary Art. The National Museum - Architecture will remain in its current building. The National Museum holds one of the world's finest collections by Edvard Munch; Other highlights include Tidemand and Gude's national-romantic masterpiece Bridal Procession on the Hardangerfjord as well as the work of Harald Sohlberg's Winter Night in the Rondane Mountains.

## 7. THE NATIONAL MUSEUM ARCHITECTURE

The National Museum – Architecture was adapted and extended by Sverre Fehn who was awarded the Pritzker Architecture Prize in 1997. The building is a juxtaposition of classicism and modernist architecture – an encounter between Grosch and Fehn, Norway’s most important architects of the 19th and 20th centuries respectively. The museum’s temporary exhibitions explore both contemporary architecture and historical themes. The architecture collection includes drawings and photographic material, in addition to models and other objects.

## 9. THE NORDIC BIBLE MUSEUM

The Nordic Bible Museum is the only bibelmuseum in the Nordic countries based on a collection of more than 3,000 bibles. Among the museum's most valuable bibles is an edition of the Swedish king Gustav Vasa's bible from 1541. The exhibition also includes an original page from a 15th century Gutenberg bible and unique hand-written manuscripts from the 13th century. There is also a miniature Bible collection with the world's smallest printed Bible, a King James Version exhibition and a Medieval printing press where you can print your own Bible page. ## 13. HL-SENTERET

The Norwegian Center for Holocaust and Minority Studies is a research, education and documentation center in Oslo focusing on the Holocaust, other genocides and the situation of minorities in contemporary societies.

The Center hosts a permanent exhibition on the Holocaust and the fate of the Norwegian Jews during the Second World War. There are also temporary exhibitions and an underground bunker which is open to the public.

The historical building of Villa Grande was during World War II the residence of the Norwegian collaborator and Nazi leader, Vidkun Quisling. Once a house of shame, it is now filled with activities in strong contrast to its former role.

## 14. THE KON-TIKI MUSEUM

Thor Heyerdahl (1914-2002) became world famous in 1947 for crossing the Pacific Ocean on the balsawood raft Kon-Tiki. The book about the journey was translated into 75 languages and the documentary film was awarded an Academy Award in 1951. Come see the original raft Kon-Tiki, solve the mystery of Easter Island, and learn more about Heyerdahl's role as environmental activist and ambassador of world peace, as seen in the reed ships expeditions Ra, Ra II and Tigris. Heyerdahl's archive is part of UNESCO's Memory of the World. Welcome!

The museum has a wide range of interesting indoor and outdoor exhibits placed in a unique maritime environment. The museum is both a cultural history museum as well as an archaeological administrative museum with important responsibilities for cultural heritage, above and underwater, in ten counties. The museum is located alongside the Fram Museum and the Kon-Tiki Museum at Bygdøyenes on the Bygdøy peninsula in Oslo.

## 17. NORSK FOLKEMUSEUM

Meet the people of Norway and learn about daily life. The Open-Air Museum features historic buildings from different regions re-erected as typical farmsteads and city dwellings, as well as a wooden stave church from the 1200s. May – September hosts in traditional costumes welcome you into the houses and domestic animals graze the fields. Activities make history come alive: handicraft, baking, folk music & dance. ## 18. HOLMENKOLLEN SKI JUMP & MUSEUM

From the top of Holmenkollen Ski Jump you can experience a 360 degree panoramic view of Oslo, the fjord and hinterland. Built into the mountain underneath the Ski Jump you find the world's oldest Ski Museum.

Here you can experience 4000 years of skiing history, original equipment from the polar heroes Fridtjof Nansen and Roald Amundsen and the famous Holmenkollen moose. There is also a cafeteria, museum shop and a ski simulator.

## 19. THE ROSE CASTLE

The Rose Castle is an art installation and an educational project that aims to tell the story of the occupation of Norway and the basic principles of democracy, the rule of law and humanism that were then put out of force. The Rose Castle tells the story of the war without demonizing or glorifying and touch on both known and lesser-known aspects of the occupation: the sufferings of prisoners of war, the unknown individual, everyday life, the drama of war sailors, the resistance struggles in the south and north. The artistic language aims to engage, challenge and confront. In short, bring to life.

## 20. HADELAND GLASSVERK

Hadeland Glassworks, one of Norway's most popular visitor attractions, enjoys an idyllic setting on the southern shore of the lake Randsfjord, just an hour's drive from Oslo and 45 minutes from OSL Gardermoen airport. The Glassworks was founded in 1762 and is Norway's oldest handicraft manufacturer in continuous operation. Today Hadeland Glassworks is a thriving business, which also preserves a rich history and heritage. The area around the Glassworks is like a small, charming village. At the heart of the operation is the Glass Workshop where you can see glassblowing demonstrations. We offer guided tours in the glass workshop and you can even try blowing your own glass.

## 21. KISTEFOS

Built on the grounds of a historical pulp mill, Kistefos today comprises an industrial museum, two art galleries and an impressive sculpture park in scenic surroundings. The sculpture Park has an impressive collection of works by internationally renowned contemporary artists including Yayoi Kusama, Tony Cragg, Claes Oldenburg, Anish Kapoor, Olafur Eliasson, Fernando Bottero and Elmgreen & Dragset. 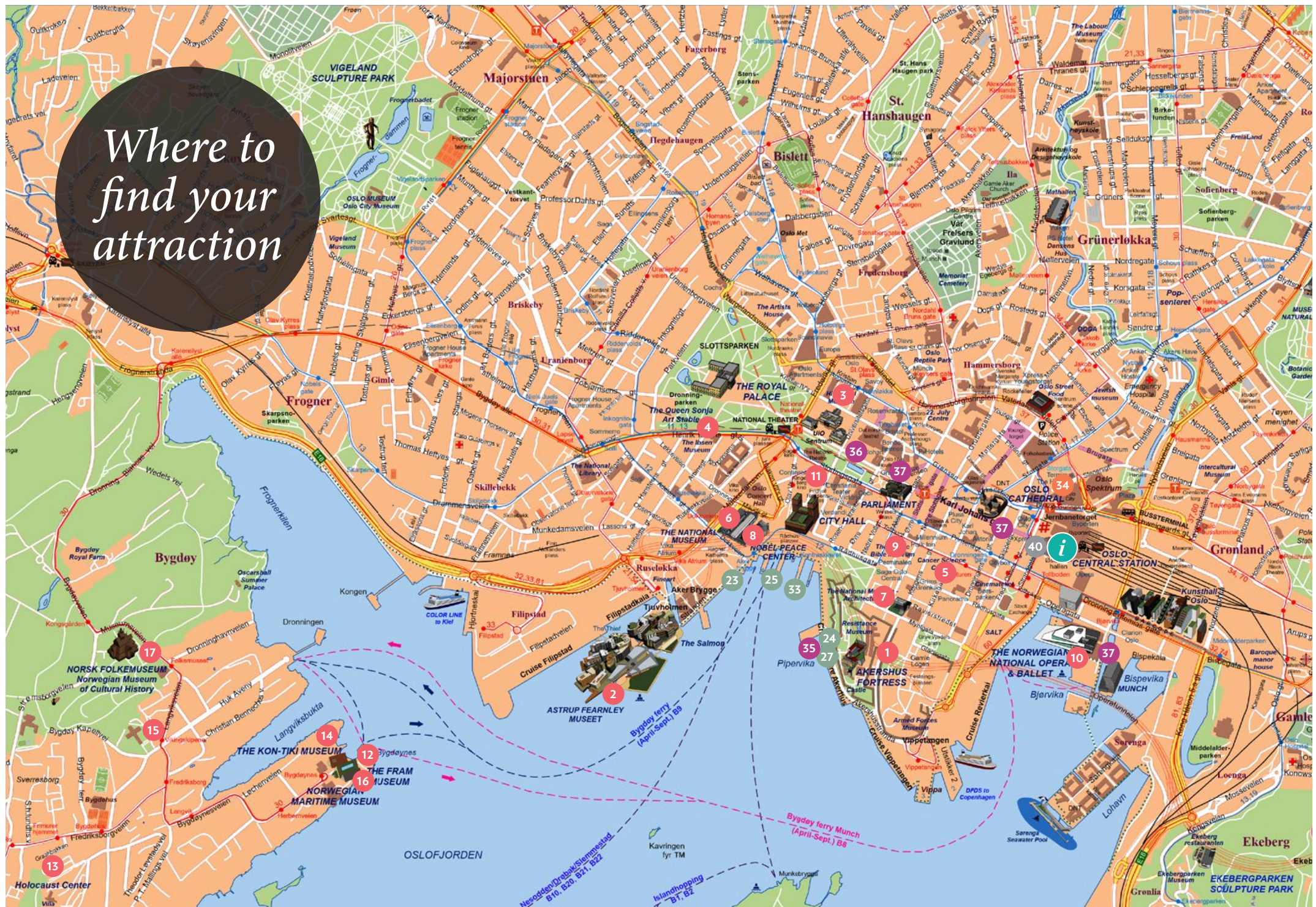

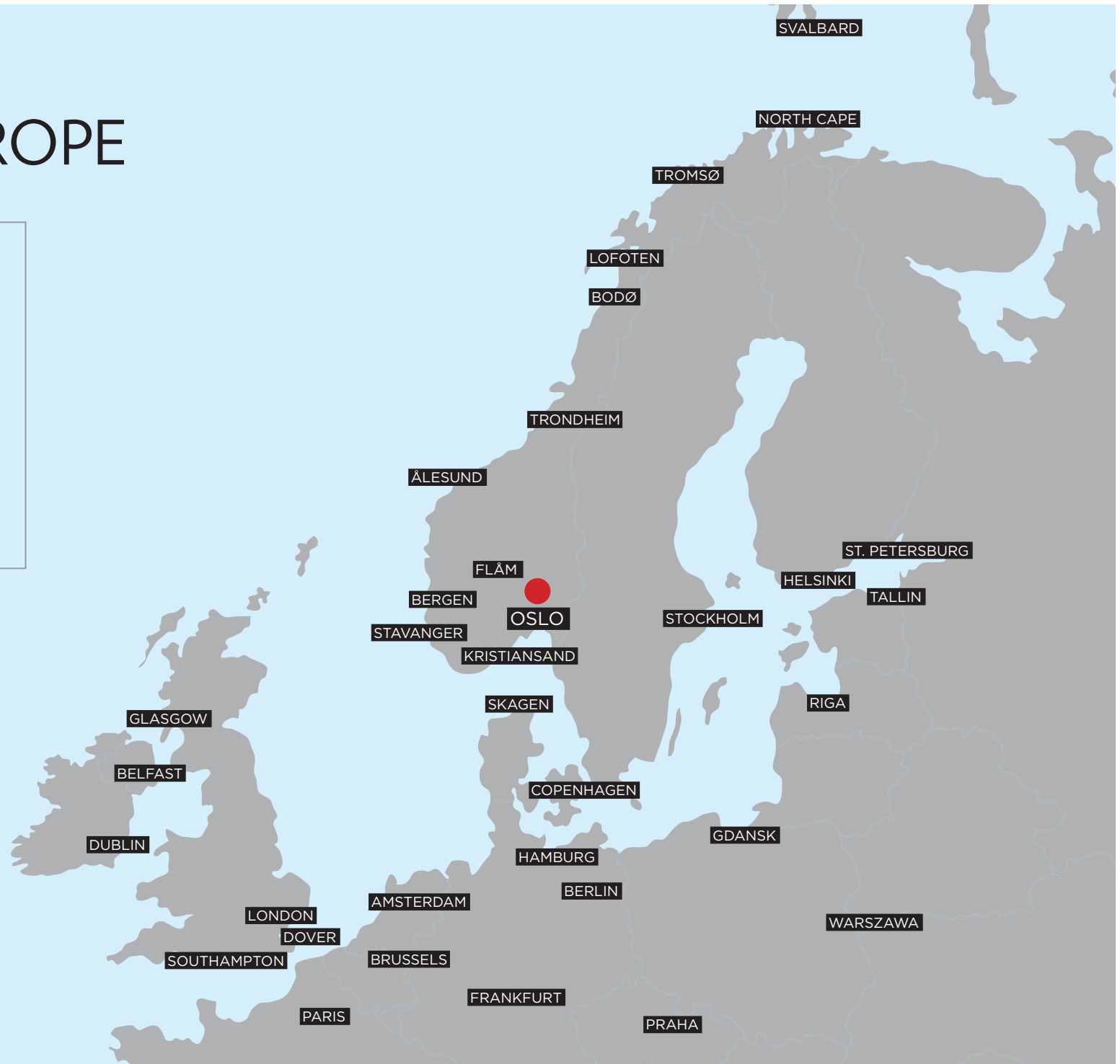
